*Weaver is informed of mistake and corrects it the same day*

**Lancaster, TN** - Terri Lynn Weaver, candidate for State Representative today released the following statement.

“We try every report to fill them out correctly. This time because the name and address on the check was different, we made an honest mistake.” Weaver continued “Today, after learning of the error we rechecked our records and determined that we needed to return money to a contributor. And we did, that is how I have always tried to conduct my family’s business, when we make a mistake, we fix it”
