PETITION FOR ORDERS OF PROTECTION

PETITIONER, Judy Martin Stanley pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-601 et seq., states:

1. Petitioner and respondent are residents of Shelby County, Tennessee, and Petitioner's address is 135 Greeff Lane, and Respondent's address is 135 Greeff Lane.

2. Petitioner and Respondent are adults? Yes No and have lived together from March '93 to Feb '94.

3. The parties have 2 minor child(ren): Write name and age of each child on the following blank lines.

That an Ex Parte Order of Protection, as provided for in Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-605, be immediately issued enjoining respondent from abusing or threatening abuse of the petitioner and that copies of the Order be served upon the respondent and filed with the Shelby County Sheriff;

2. That a hearing in this cause be set for within ten (10) days pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-3-605, and that notice of the

be served upon respondent together with the Order of Protection;

X 3. That upon the hearing of this cause, petitioner be granted an extended Order of Protection for a period of one (1) year.

_____ 4. That upon the hearing of this cause, petitioner be awarded temporary custody of the parties' minor child(ren).

_____ 5. That upon the hearing of this cause, respondent be ordered to pay reasonable support for petitioner;

_____ 6. That upon the hearing of this cause, respondent be ordered to pay reasonable support for the parties' child(ren).

_____ 7. That upon the hearing of this cause, exclusive possession of the parties' residence be awarded to petitioner, or that the respondent be ordered to provide alternate housing for petitioner;

X 8. That respondent pay the costs and litigation tax of this cause;

X 9. For general relief.
