ALTERNATIVE WRIT OF MANDAMUS

WHEREAS DAVE ROSENBERG, as relator, on the 1 day of Sept., 2010 presented his Complaint to this Court alleging that you, the Davidson County Election Commission, have failed to require further identifying information to reduce misleading or confusing voters using the 2010 general ballot in Davidson County, Tennessee as will more fully appear by reference to said Complaint herewith served upon you; and whereas the said Chancellor has ordered an alternative writ of mandamus to issue as demanded in said Complaint.

YOU ARE THERETOFORE COMMANDED to require further identifying information on the 2010 general election ballot so that the Republican candidate for the 50th District of the Tennessee House of Representatives is described by either his legal name, "Dymon Dave Hall," or that name under which he sought nomination, "Dymon Hall," in order to reduce misleading or confusing voters using that ballot or appear before this Court on the 13 day of SEPTEMBER at 9:00 A.M.




